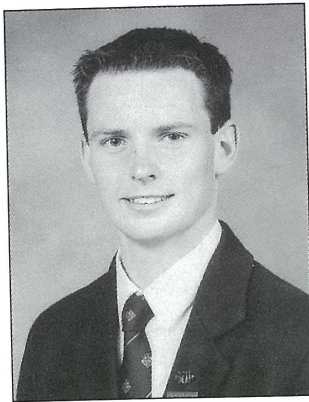
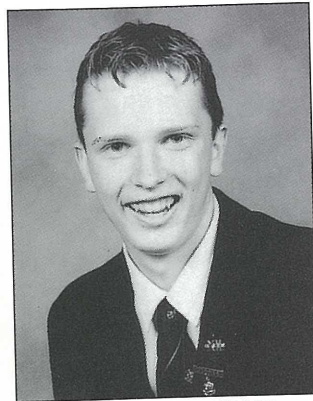


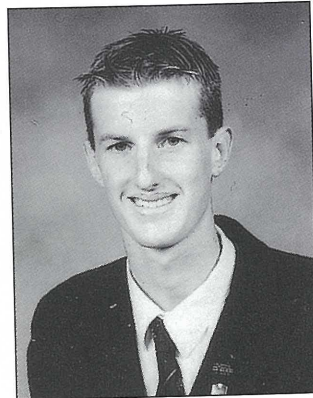

WILL LISTON TROPHY

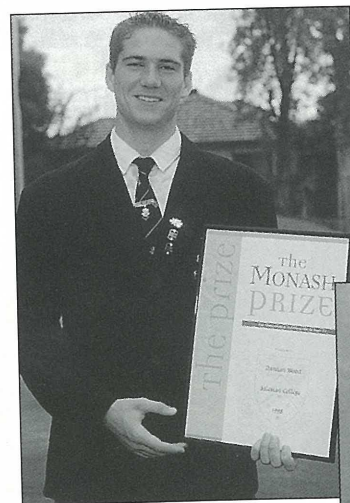

MONASH PRIZE FOR EXCELLENCE

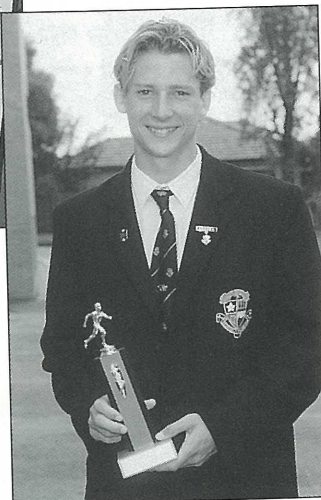

SPORTSMAN OF THE YEAR

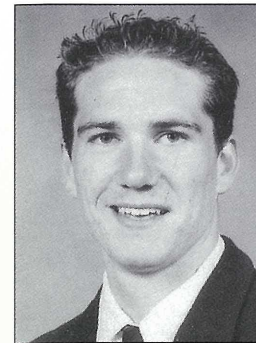
