Role Description

The Outdoor Education Assistant provides support to teachers in the delivery of the College's Year 9 Outdoor Education program one day per week.

The Outdoor Education Assistant is also responsible for assisting with camp and excursion arrangements and the safe conduct of outdoor education activities.

Within the role, the Outdoor Education Assistant supports the Catholic Identity and Evangelising Mission and works collaboratively with other staff and members of the school community to support students to achieve enhanced learning outcomes.

The Outdoor Education Assistant will work under the general supervision and direction of the Year 9 Outdoor Education staff and the Head of Human Development.

Candidates seeking a full-time position may also be considered for the role of a Learning Support Officer (please see separate advertisement.)

Tasks

- Provide support to the teachers in the delivery of educational programs to students, specifically Outdoor Education.

- Assist with instruction in various outdoor recreation activities

- Work with students to use specialised equipment where required.

- Support students in class work as required by classroom teachers.

- Assist students on excursions and special events.

- Supervise students in small group activity settings
