#### FOCUS ON OPEN DAYS

If you are considering studying at TAFE or university after school, it is **crucial** that you attend Open Days.

Throughout the year, vocational and tertiary institutions open their doors (virtually for some) to the public and showcase their courses, accommodation, scholarships, pathway courses, student services and their 'point of difference'. At an Open Day, you will be able to:

Get a feel for the culture of the campus

Learn about courses and career options

Undertake virtual campus and accommodation tours

Speak directly to student ambassadors and lecturers about the courses or careers you are interested in

Compare the course area you are interested in at different institutions

Learn about sports and societies you can join and be active in

Get course counselling and guidance

Attend information sessions and workshops

Watch live demonstrations

Don't pick a course at an institution without visiting (even just virtually) the campus – you potentially will be spending several years studying there and spending tens of thousands of dollars on your course and accommodation. It's worth making the effort.

By now you should have identified institutions you would like to visit, the next step is to visit their website to register for their event (either on campus or virtual).

**Remember that due to current COVID-19 related restrictions, places for on-campus events will be limited, so register your interest now.**
