SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

OFFERED TO STUDENTS FROM
YEARS 8 - 12

Salesian College Chadstone is committed to awarding scholarships on an annual basis to recognise excellence in academic and co-curricular activities.

Since the inception of our Scholarship Program many recipients have gone on to achieve amazing academic results and to perform exceptionally well in their university courses, and are now entering the workforce as fine examples of Salesian men.

The outstanding results achieved by Salesian College students must be attributed to the dedication and commitment of teaching staff and the pastoral care and wellbeing programs offered at the College, fostering an environment of support and care for each individual student.

The attainment of a scholarship at each year level recognises a student's achievement at the highest level. Each scholarship recipient is to maintain and build on the intensity from the early year levels into the senior years.

Devised to encourage our students at each year level to achieve their personal best, the Scholarship Program aims to recognise, reinforce and reward our high achieving students, as well as those with gifts in the performing arts and sport.

Salesian College Chadstone is committed to awarding scholarships on an annual basis to recognise personal excellence in academic, curricular and extra-curricular pursuits.

Aim

- To recognise, reinforce and reward the culture of high achievement and excellence within the College
- To attract and retain 'high achieving' students as role models for our student population

Scholarship Guidelines

The College will award scholarships on an annual basis to recognise academic excellence and personal excellence in curricular and co-curricular activities. The Scholarships are independent of financial circumstances.

- Scholarships are offered to Year Levels 8 to 12 as detailed in the Scholarships Offered Table below
- All students are eligible to be considered for scholarships
- Scholarship testing will occur for all Year 8, 9 and 10 students in April
- The Principal may use his discretion to award additional scholarships from time to time

Scholarships will be awarded for:

- Academic Excellence
- General Excellence
- The amount will be deducted from the award recipient's fee account for one-year

subject to the student's ongoing satisfactory academic performance

- Families will sign a contract that clearly states that if a scholarship recipient leaves the College without a reason acceptable to the College they must pay back the total amount of the scholarships provided to him across his time at the College.

- All Scholarship decisions will be final and at the sole discretion of the Principal – no correspondence will be entered into with unsuccessful students.

Selection Criteria

Academic Scholarships

YEAR 8 - 10

- Based on ACER testing results and all academic results including examinations and assessments. A student must be achieving at an excellent level as well as contributing positively to the life of the College.

General Excellence Scholarships

General Excellence Scholarships may be awarded to students who are achieving a high academic standard and who are achieving at an excellent standard in one or more of the following areas:

- Academic
- Sporting
- Performing Arts

YEAR 7

- Not applicable

YEAR 8 -10

- Based on ACER testing results and all academic results including examinations and assessments. Student must be achieving at high level and have demonstrated excellence in one or more of the areas outlined above.
- Students who participate and perform at a high level of performance in sport and performing arts are able to receive this general excellence scholarship.
- A student must partake in the life of the College and their values align with the College and become evident to others.
- A sports scholarship recipient must participant for the College in their chosen sport/s as well as represent the College in team ACC events, as applicable.
- A performing arts scholarship recipient must maintain their commitment to the College music program (instrumental, band and ensemble program) and/or theatrical program.

YEAR 11 and 12

- Based on all academic results including examinations. Student must be achieving a high level above 75% and have demonstrated excellence in one or more of the areas outlined above.
- Students who participate and perform at a high level of performance in sport and performing arts are able to receive this general excellence scholarship.
- A student must partake in the life of the College and their values align with the College and become evident to others.
- A sports scholarship recipient must participant for the College in their chosen sport/s as well as represent the College in team ACC events, as applicable.
- A cultural scholarship recipient must maintain their commitment to the College music program (instrumental, band and ensemble program) and/or theatrical program.

Awarding of Scholarships

The Principal in collaboration with members of the Leadership Team, members of the Scholarship Committee, Year Level Coordinators, and Heads of Departments will award the scholarships annually based on the above criteria. All students are eligible and there is no official application process.

The Scholarships for Years 8-12 will be awarded at the following events at the College Dux Assembly.

Scholarship Committee

The Assistant Principal – Learning and Teaching, Assistant Principal – Students and Engagement, Head of Sport, Head of Performing Arts, Director of Music and Data Mentor make up the Scholarship Committee. Collectively they make recommendations to the Principal who makes the final decision regarding scholarships at Salesian College Chadstone.

All communication to families regarding scholarship offers will come from the office of the Principal with the support of the Registrar.
