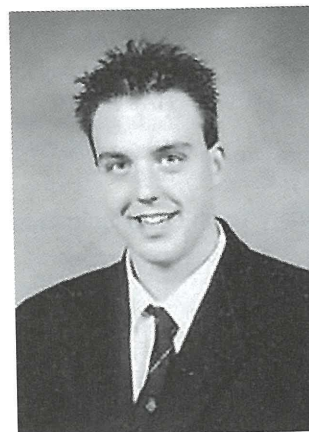
Will Liston Trophy

Sportsman of the Year

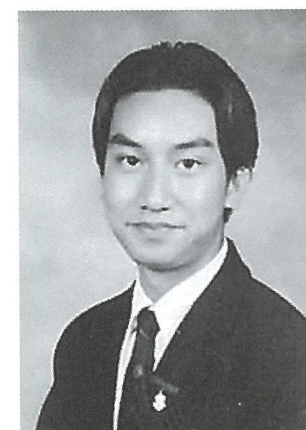

Paul was selected in the Victorian Men's Under 18 Basketball Team. A highlight, training with the Australian Women's Olympic Team preparing for Sydney 2000.

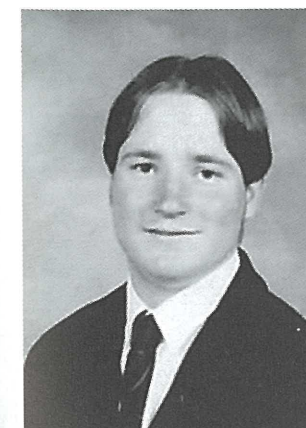

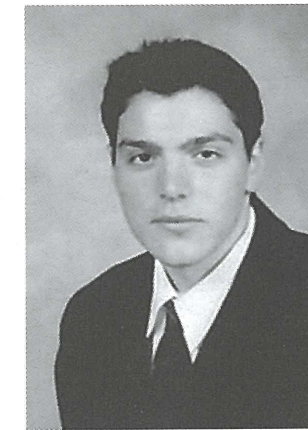

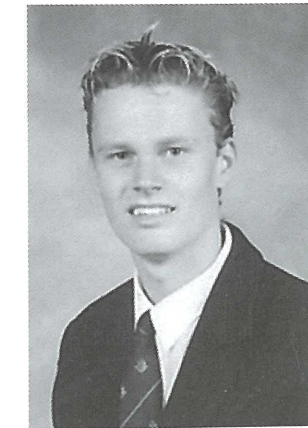
